



Dedication Story

You may write whatever you like in the dedication story. The idea is to tell something about who the man is and why he's special to you. You can write it as a letter to him or as a story describing him. You can use prose, poetry, dialogue, lyrics, a collection of quotes or whatever form you choose. Due to space on the page, we recommend stories ranging between 1 and 350 words.

The dedication story will be included in the publication as you write it. You should use spelling, tense, punctuation, case and grammar as you want the words to appear in the book. We prefer that the story be typed, but will accept dedication stories written in very, very neat handwriting. All the stories will be reviewed by an editor before publishing.

All dedication stories are expected to end with the salutation line: Love, [Dedicator's Name(s)]. Please end your story with this line. Be sure to include your name in the salutation exactly as you would like it to appear in the book. If there is more than one dedicator, please be sure everyone's name is listed in the spelling and order the names are to appear in the book.

Please use the attached form to write your dedication story. The story must be submitted to the Alma Center by e-mail, fax or U.S. mail within two weeks of your order.
